

Linear Classification for a Dexter Bull

A bull can be reclassified at a later age. If the score on that occasion is higher than the score he achieved previously then his higher score will count. If the second score is lower than the earlier score then the first score still stands and will not be downgraded.

Classification cost for a bull is £15 + VAT = £18.00
