

# Linear Classification for a Dexter Cow or Heifer

Classification will only be carried out on in-milk cows or heifers - at least 1 month in milk.

Dry cows will not be classified.

*A heifer or cow can be reclassified at a later age. If the score on that occasion is higher than the score she achieved previously then her higher score will count. If the second score is lower than the earlier score then the first score still stands and will not be downgraded.*

**Classification cost for a cow/heifer is £6.00 + VAT = £7.20**
