

Carlisle Sale – Borderway Mart

The 28th Annual Carlisle Rare and Minority Breeds Sale on 19th September 2020 was very different to previous sales due to Covid 19 restrictions. The Border Dexter Group was unable to host the pre-sale supper which had become a social highlight of the year for many current and potential Dexter breeders/owners. The annual show of Dexters could not go ahead and the pre-sale inspections had to be done visually from outside the pens by the three DCS inspectors present. Only two people per entry and registered buyers were allowed to attend so the usual buzz around the pens and in the ring was missing.

The majority of cattle forward were halter trained, well presented and of good quality.

32 registered & 1 unregistered Dexters were entered. There were 9 not forward (mainly due to being sold before the sale).

Bulls – 3 forward 1 sold for £3,200.00 average £3,200. Jean Nuttall breaking her Carlisle sale record with Brenin Llewellyn EX95.

Cows – 5 forward 2 sold average £225.00.

Heifers – 15 forward 1 not sold average £518.00. Top price female going to the maiden heifer Planetree Kleio £1,100.00 and 2 of Candy King's in calf heifers making £800.00 each.
